Bangor International Airport

Bangor International Airport (BGR) is a full service international airport located in Bangor, Maine. Located in the Northeast United States, Bangor serves as an uncongested entry point to the United States and a popular transit point for technical stops and aircraft diversions. Some of BGR's unique selling points include: all weather access CAT III, 11,440 foot runway, 24 hour Federal inspection services for U.S. Port of Entry, excellent weather record, capability of handling any aircraft currently flying, 24 hour FAA ATC Tower, competitive fuel prices and an excellent service reputation. BGR is owned and operated by the City of Bangor as an enterprise fund, and is the principle domestic air service provider for a regional market of 410,000 people in the Maine catchment area with another 279,000 less than three (3) hours away in Canada.



BGR's Domestic Terminal is currently undergoing a \$14 million remodel to modernize the terminal and the passenger experience. It is anticipated that all the renovations will be completed by July 2016. Additionally a new gate is being added which is scheduled for completion in December 2016.

Currently, BGR provides year-round non-stop service on Allegiant, American, and Delta. Seasonal service is provided by United. Resident airlines offer year-round daily non-stop service to Detroit (DTW), New York (LGA), Philadelphia (PHL), and Washington, D.C. (DCA) and seasonal summer service into mid-autumn daily to Chicago (ORD) and Newark (EWR). Allegiant flies non-stop to Orlando/Sanford (SFO) and Tampa/St. Petersburg (PIE) with seasonal schedule adjustments.

Bangor is just one stop away for most travelers including those from European hubs such as Amsterdam, Paris, London, and Frankfurt. While many US travelers arrive either non-stop from one of BGR's hubs, or one-stop from many cities, sometimes two-stops are necessary from smaller cities.

As of June 2016, BGR has 1-3 flights per day from Washington, DC, Philadelphia, Detroit, Chicago, and New York LaGuardia and Newark with 1-6 flights weekly from Sanford/Orlando and Tampa/St. Petersburg depending upon the season.

BGR is located close to many hotels with one hotel connected right to the terminal. Just minutes to downtown Bangor and the conference and entertainment center and 1-2 hours to many of Maine's top attractions.
